

## **Parent Involvement/Volunteer Hours**

Dear St. Thomas Families,

Partnership is a foundational block for Catholic education. St. Thomas School needs the help of all of its families to continue to provide education at the lowest possible cost. Each year the St. Thomas PTO is responsible for raising \$50,000. To reach this goal, the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) administers a Family Participation Program. The Family Participation Program is designed to have parents become actively involved in the school and its fundraising activities.

Service is the heart of our faith community and, therefore, parents are required to donate twenty-five (25) hours per family, regardless of the number of children attending St. Thomas School. Families who have pre-kindergarten students in the three (3) day program are responsible for fifteen (15) hours.

Any family member who is of high school age or older may help fulfill parent involvement hours.

We are asking all St. Thomas families to complete our parent volunteer form (see reverse) and return it to the main office before September 13, 2024.

Family volunteers offer a huge resource and support base for our school community and model the importance of service to the larger community. Volunteering at these events is also fun and can be a great way to connect with other St. Thomas families!
